Sealed Bids subject to the conditions contained herein will be received by the Mohawk Valley Water Authority (MVWA), Engineering Department, up until and no later than **11:00 A.M. local time on, Thursday, September 24, 2026** and then publicly opened and read in the Board's conference room for the following, as described in the specifications: **2026 Generator Replacements (25-01-B)**.

The scope of work includes removing existing diesel engine/alternator, automatic transfer switch, and appurtenances from interior and exterior of six of the following existing pump station buildings:

- **Christensen Road Pump Station**
- **Hangar Road Pump Station**
- **Mallory Road Pump Station**
- **Route 12 Pump Station**
- **Southern Reservoir Pump Station**
- **Deerfield Meter Station**

Furnish and install new diesel engine/alternator, automatic transfer switch, and appurtenances as shown and described in the Contract Documents will be the responsibility of the Contractor.

Proposals shall be submitted only on the forms contained herein and shall include a five percent (5%) bid security in the form described and shall be received only from persons who obtain Bid Documents from the MVWA and are duly registered on the list of bidders.

The MVWA reserves the right to waive any informality and reject any and all bids. The MVWA may reject any bid if in its judgment the resources, financial standing, or experience of the bidder justifies such rejection in view of the work to be performed. The Board reserves the right to revise or amend the bidding documents prior to the date set for opening the bids.
